

**VILLAGE OF VISCOUNT
BYLAW 2016-43**

A Bylaw to Classify, License, Regulate and Govern Businesses

The Council of the Village of Viscount in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression "transient trader" shall mean a person carrying on business in a municipality who:
 - a. Offers goods or merchandise for sale by retail or auction; or
 - b. Solicits any person who is not a wholesaler or retail dealer for orders for the future delivery of goods or merchandise.
2. In this bylaw the expression "direct seller" shall mean a person who:
 - a. Goes from house to house selling or offering for sale, or soliciting orders for the future delivery of, goods or services;
 - b. By telephone offers for sale or solicits orders for the future delivery of goods or services; or
 - c. Does both of the things mentioned in subclauses (a) and (b).
3. No person shall carry on any of the businesses set out in section 9 of this bylaw within the Village unless they possess a valid and subsisting licence for the purpose issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
4. The Administrator of the Village is hereby authorised to issue a licence to any person carrying on business in the Village:
 - a. Who is not assessable by the Village for the purposes of business taxation in respect for that business; and
 - b. Who makes application for such licence stating specifically the nature of their business in the Village; and
 - c. Who has complied with the Auctioneers Act if the same applies or may apply in respect of the licence for which they have made application under this bylaw; and
 - d. Who tenders with under this application the proper licence fee as herein provided for.
5. Subject to the right of council to suspend or revoke the same, as provided by "The Municipalities Act", every licence issued hereunder shall remain in force and effect until and including the thirty-first day of December of the year of issue.
6. Every licence issued hereunder shall specifically state the kinds of services, goods or merchandise which the licensee is authorised to offer for sale of or take orders as the case may be and whether in the case of the goods or merchandise, they may offer the same for sale be retail or by public auction or both. Such licence shall also state the restrictions as set forth in Section 7 hereof.
7. No person to whom a licence has been granted under this bylaw shall offer for sale services, goods or merchandise or solicit orders for future delivery of goods or merchandise within the Village:
 - a. Other than of a kind or kinds described in the licence; or
 - b. By any method except as authorized therein; or
8. Every person licensed under this bylaw shall, at all reasonable times, upon request of the Administrator, the Village Foreman or license inspector, or any peace officer produce such licence for inspection purposes.
9. Subject to Section 5, the fee payable for a licence under this bylaw shall be as follows:
 - a. For a Transient Trader \$100
 - b. Direct Seller \$100
10. Bylaw No. 18-80 is hereby repealed.
11. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on September 13, 2016.
