BYLAW 2019-59

BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF VISCOUNT TO FIX THE

WATER AND SEWER RATES.

The Council of the Village of Viscount in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

PART I – GENERAL

1. Every owner or user who wishes to obtain water and sewer services to any premises shall make application to the Village of Viscount and pay all necessary fees and charges levied for the installation of services lines, meters and any information deemed necessary for the provision of water and sewer service.
2. **Billing**
 - (a) Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of one month. Accounts shall be paid by the 25th day of the next month.
 - (b) The penalty on all water and/or sewer accounts that are unpaid after the 25th of the next month shall be 2% of the arrears amount, per month and the water service may be shut off.
 - (c) When the water service is shut off due to non-payment of account, it shall not be resumed until all arrears have been paid together with a reconnection fee of \$100.00.
3. The charges to be paid by the Consumer who's water service has been turned on shall be those set as follows:

0 - 2000 gallons or less	Minimum \$ 56.00/month
2000- 16 000 gallons or more	\$ 5.25 per 1000 gallons
Over 16 000 gallons	\$ 5.75 per 1000 gallons
4. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by Bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services as follows:

Monthly Flat fee:


Schools	\$64.00/month
Car Wash and Community Arena	\$32.00/month
Residence and all other users	\$14.00/month
5. Every property with a current connection shall pay an infrastructure fee as follows:


Infrastructure Fee	\$ 10.00/month
--------------------	----------------
6. Hauling direct from distribution plant per 1,000 gallons \$25.00
After hours charge \$35.00
7. The rates and charges contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board, or September 1, 2019, whichever is later.
8. Bylaw 2017-048 is repealed effective upon the coming into force of this Bylaw.


